1. Write down all the names given to Jesus by the writer of Hebrews.

2. What do those names mean to you in your life right now?

3. What do you think C.S. Lewis meant when he said:

"I am trying here to prevent anyone from saying the really foolish thing that people often say about Him [Jesus Christ]: *I'm ready to accept Jesus as a great moral teacher, but I don't accept his claim to be God.* That is the one thing we must not say. A man who was merely a man and said the sort of things Jesus said would not be a great moral teacher. He would either be a lunatic — on a level with a man who says he is a poached egg — or else he would be the Devil of Hell.

You must make your choice. Either this man was, and is, the Son of God, or else a madman or something worse... You can shut him up for fool, you can spit at him and kill him as a demon, or you can fall at his feet and call him Lord and God. But let us not come up with any patronizing nonsense about his being a great human teacher. He has not left that option open to us. He did not intend to."
